## Dress Cards

Ladies' dress cards are fun to make and excite your recipients with your creativity. You can adapt them to any occasion, birthday, holiday, seasonal or even a bridal shower theme. (This is a great project to make use of your scrap paper.)

The diecuts below, among many others, are currently available from Amazon in many different dress styles. There is the pleated skirt design with alternate tops – which requires folding along the scored lines, and other styles that are flat. (The pictures of the finished dresses help to show the way to fold each pleat). Once your dress pattern is complete, it is fun to add adhesive rhinestones or pearls, thin washi tape or ribbon for a waistband, and other embellishments. It is also helpful to find your card's background base paper first, then select a coordinating pattern for your dress. Have fun with your little fashion runway!
